

Parking Entry Anti Passback System

Anti Passback Security Measures Prevent Successive entries by multiple people with the same access card, preventing “passing back” of the same access card.

There are various iterations of the Anti Passback measure, including soft, hard, area, and timed Anti Passback measures. Deciding which variant of Anti Passback access control is right for your business is dependent on your security requirements.

Type of Anti Passback

= **Hard Anti Passback**

When the Anti Passback rule is violated, the cardholder will be denied access.

= **Soft Anti Passback**

A violation of the Anti Passback rules will result in granted access, but administrators of the system will receive an alert of the incident and the associated cardholder.

= **Area Anti Passback**

Until a card is used at an ‘in’ reader at the entrance to the building, the card will not work at any readers inside the building.

= **Timed Anti Passback**

Once a card has been used to enter an area, it cannot be used at the same reader again until the defined time period has passed, for example, 15 minutes.
